First things first of course...



-Add your personal social media info.

-Add pics and videos.

-Click EDIT and you can add a bio, change spelling of your name, etc.

Look at the top row of options...

-Reviews is a tab just for press. You can't enter anything here. I'm working with Stagey on making this more accessible.

-Click on Details (we'll get to the rest later).

This is a big important page!

-Underneath the main image, see the little + pictures and + videos. There is no recommended pic size, and the site is actually really flexible about whatever size you add. If you add something too small (say, 200x200 pixels) or too big (some 11x17y inches), it might not look as great, in which case, just try another size.

-You can (and should) add multiple pics. You can change your "hero image" anytime by clicking the little star icon under the photo.

-For videos, just note that it has to be linked through YouTube or Vimeo. You can't add an mp4 or mov, or any extant file.

-You can also click on Modify tags and adjust those any time.

-Scroll down to the bottom of the page and you'll see Invite Team. I strongly recommend that you invite anyone that is helping you with your show to the show page. This 1) acknowledges their efforts to support you and 2) gives you someone else invested in promoting your show besides yourself.

INTERVIEW WITH PRODUCER/ACTRESS DAHLIA WAINGORT GUIGUI October 08, 2024

Interview with Producer/Actress Dahlia Waingort Guigui

You have an impressive acting and resume. When did you first get interested in acting and where did that journey take you?
I began acting when I was 8. I attended Performing Arts schools throughout primary education and graduated from New World School of the Arts High School in Miami, Florida. I then studied at Oxford School of Drama in England with Sir Richard Attenborough and Arthur Miller. I dove into the British theatre and had the honor of performing at The National Theatre in London and wonderful theatres in the West End. I moved to California soon after and began my film and TV career while still doing theatre in LA through the years.

Now you are a producer, COO and Head of Production at Sunset Pictures, which has an eclectic roster of projects produced. It's a big step to owning a production company. How did that come about?
When I met my husband almost 25 years ago, he had just directed


